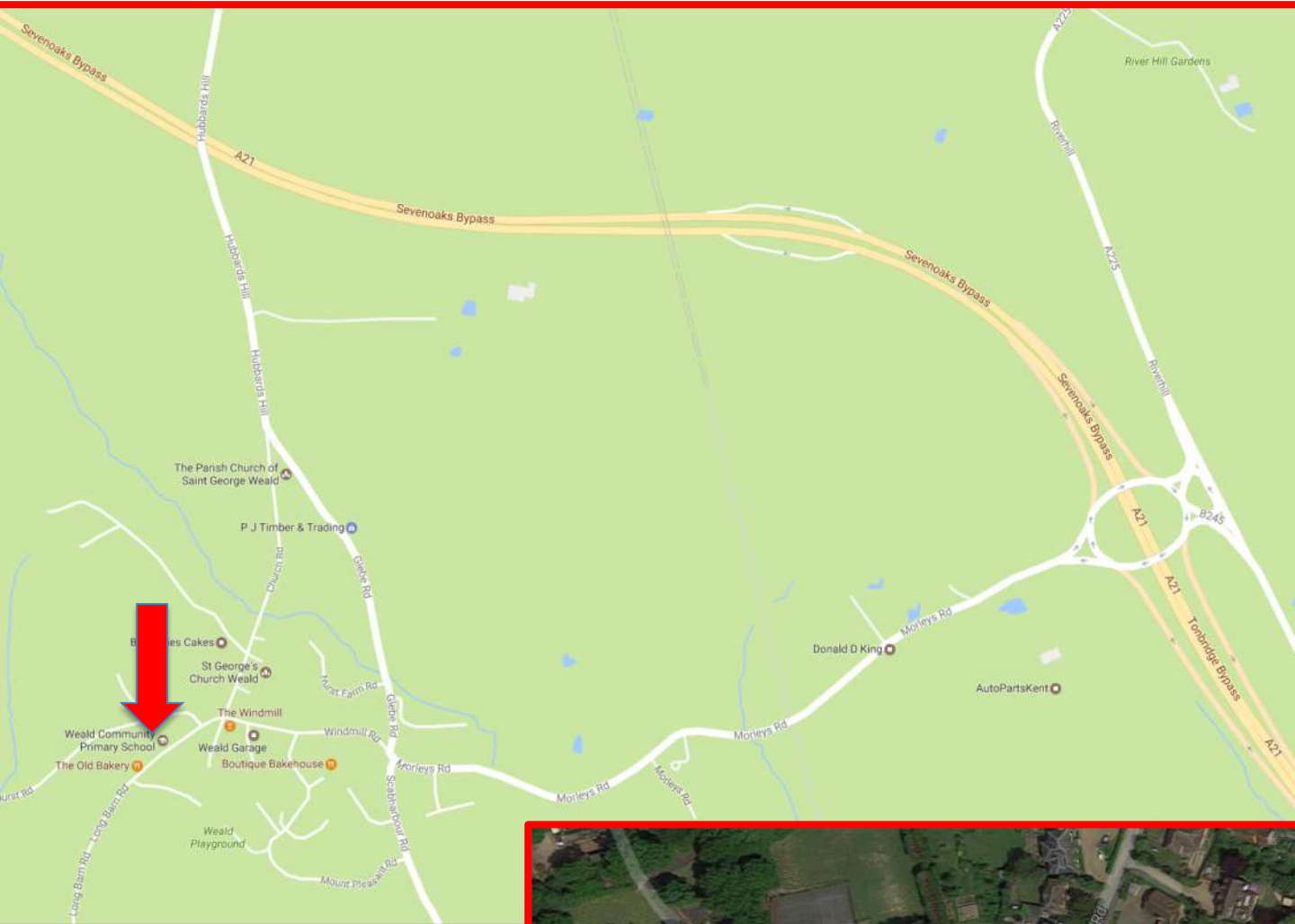

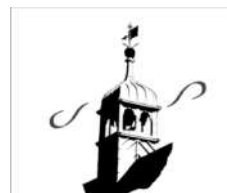

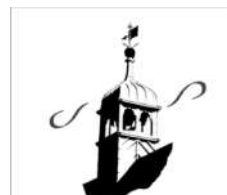




Tournament “Need to Knows”



- Both the Mini-bridge and the Main Bridge Sessions will be Duplicate Sessions run by a Coordinating EBU Tournament Director and two TD's (one in each Hall). They will adjudicate on all bridge related rulings and will score the sessions. Their decisions are final.
- The Competition will be run in the spirit of gentle competitive bridge and about a dozen experienced local bridge players will be on hand to assist with scoring, bidding queries and play queries.
- Our Safe Guarding Officer for the event is Richard Banbury.
- Cooldrinks and cookies will be supplied, and further cakes and savouries will be on sale on the green (proceeds go to Christian Aid Week).
- All children under the age of 14 (on 31 August) are eligible.
- There will be three categories: Mini-bridge, Secondary School Bridge and Primary School Bridge. Trophies will be awarded to Winners and Runners-up in each of these categories.
- Medals and Participation Certificates will be awarded to all participants completing the two afternoon sessions.
- EBU and West Kent Youth Bridge Officials will be on hand to discuss up-coming events, the Junior Award System and how bridge in schools can be supported.
- Please make sure participating children arrive at registration before 12:45pm and are collected promptly by 18:30.
- Players can register online (on the Kent Contract Bridge Association website or complete the included registration form and email this to kent.youth.bridge@gmail.com or hand it in at registration. No signed form, no participation.
- Results will be available on the EBU website and a link made available through the WCPS web-page after the event.
