

## **RETURN TO FACE-TO-FACE BRIDGE SESSIONS**

***Do not come to the bridge club if you have Covid or flu-like symptoms, if you have been in a hotspot during the previous 14 days, or if you have associated with anyone who has Covid symptoms during the previous 14 days.***

The Kiama and District Bridge Club Committee has agreed that face to face bridge sessions will recommence on Tuesday 5 January 2021. Sessions will be the same as before the lockdown, but the Wednesday morning session will not be restricted to under 50 MPs. The bridge club will continue to monitor NSW Health rules and recommendations. Members will be notified by email if the situation changes. Please check the website for current information.

Note that the AFL rebuild is underway so parking is limited and it could get noisy. We will be using the glass door near the kitchen to enter and exit the club.

We have to abide by NSW Health's Covid plan for Community Centres and Halls. This includes the 2 square metre rule which allows us to have a maximum of 87 people in the clubhouse. You'll find the plan on the home page of our website, and there are copies in the club. Here's what you'll need to do when you come to play bridge.

### **Entry into the club**

- When you come to your first session, you will need to sign an agreement that you won't come to the club if you have been in contact with Covid-19 or in a hotspot in the previous 14 days, that you don't have flu-like symptoms and that you agree to abide by the KDBC Covid-19 safety plan.
- The club has the right to refuse entry, or ask you to leave, if you appear unwell.
- There'll be hand sanitiser at the door as well as the two dispensers on the wall and you must either use sanitiser or wash your hands when you come in.

### **Playing, cleaning and hygiene**

- You must sanitise your hands at the beginning of each round. Make sure the sanitiser has dried before you touch any cards.
- At the end of the session North will ensure that the tables, chairs, side stools, bidding board and Bridge mate are cleaned with disinfectant wipes and that all rubbish is placed in the appropriate bin.
- All used surfaces in the club need to be cleaned after each session. We'll need two volunteers. A tick-off cleaning list is supplied.
- Face masks are recommended, however don't expect that all players will wear one.

### **Physical distancing and ventilation**

- We need to have good ventilation so dress appropriately.
- We can only allow 2 people in both the men's and ladies' toilet areas, so no-one in the hand washing area of the ladies.
- Please observe 1.5m social distancing when not seated.
- The kitchen area is out of bounds, except to nominated cleaners, Directors and Committee members.

## Refreshments

- The physical distancing and hygiene requirements set by NSW Health mean we can't have tea and coffee or biscuits. Bring a water bottle and your own refreshments. Please don't bring food to share.

## Table Fees

- You can purchase a \$50 pack of 10 vouchers either using cash or prepaying using EFT – you'll need to bring proof of payment. You can also choose to pay \$5 cash but please have the right money. Cash and vouchers will be collected from the tables.
