The monthly meeting was called to order at 12 noon at Casa Linda.

**President's Report:**

Tournament: Jimmy let us know that the club is asking 4400 pesos from the Tequila Regional Tournament to offset the projected loss of income for the Tuesday, Thursday and Friday games.

The Unit has negotiated tournament fees for all current LCDBC members to be 250 pesos, rather than the 400 peso fees for all others.

Set up for the tournament Sunday at 12:30 and Monday at 10. Please help if you can.
