

GAME DIRECTOR/COMPUTER OPERATOR JOB DESCRIPTION:

All sanctioned games must be directed by a certified Game Director. The Game Director will establish the Game Movement - which is the method of progression during the game – and the boards to be played by each player at each round.

A non-playing director is preferable, however, to fill a half-table. Game Directors may play since we use the automatic scorers. This should not be done when there are two sections.

No Game Director shall direct more than two sections per game day.

All sanctioned games must have a Game Director/Computer Operator for scoring club games and masterpoint records. Game Director and Computer Operator may be one in the same.

The Club Manager will assist the director at the end of the game to print out the final results, print personal summaries for those individuals that have requested them, and for posting the final results on the Lee County Bridge Web page and the ACBL Live Web page.

Membership is encouraged to assist whenever possible, including, but not limited to table setup, and cleanup duties.

The Game Director shall assist in putting away the Director/Computer Operator Table, the Board Table, and the cash box. On Fridays all other items will be put away with the assistance of volunteers and the club manager.

COMPENSATION:

The Game Director / Computer Operator will receive \$100.00 per game. At this time the Board has limited the game to 22 tables.
