	I was from June 2006 until July 2017 the EBU General Manager and Company Secretary. Prior to that my career was in IT, founding my own company in 1978 and selling it to a US public company in 1998.
	I have substantial experience at Board level, from my own business and as EBU GM, where I attended something like 65 Board meetings providing advice and support to Board members and the Chairmen, from time to time.

	I was for eleven years the EBU General Manager.
	Shortly after starting in post, I became a member of the Membership Development Action Group (MDAG), and ultimately managed the process of modifying the EBU's systems so as to be able to implement Universal Membership. This process went live with no issues at all. As a result of these system changes we were able to design and implement the National Grading System, a project that I initiated and ultimately I chaired the group that designed and wrote that software. During this period we implemented an IT environment for bridge (USEBIO) that was initially developed by an EBU member, Chris Stableford. That structure underpins all that the EBU does in IT terms with bridge data, and is now used in full or part by others. It is Open Source and free to use.
	I have a great interest in helping to develop and maintain the environment of club bridge so that our affiliated clubs can flourish. I mentored the developers of Pianola (in my own time) who sought to provide facilities to clubs so as to make their lives easier. Pianola is now in use by the EBU, and in a number of other bridge federations around the world.
	Since my retirement I have been assisting the EBU in attempting to get NGS implemented by other bridge federations and in the sale of EBUScore to other federations.
