However, an aggressive North could choose a pre-empt, opposite a passed partner, leaving the opening side with work to do to get to game. In pass-out seat, West may choose a take-out double, as they have no trick source for 3NT, and only a single diamond stopper. An imaginative East, knowing that a hand with some aces and a club fit would give them nine tricks in no-trumps can choose 3NT.</p> <p>On the lead of the ♠2 spade, which feels natural on the auction, North will win and continue. Easts who open 1♠ will see a simple raise to 2♠ and will often be allowed to play there. South on lead isn't spoiled for choice here and should opt for a passive heart to the ♥A, after which North's natural choice might be a club. East can win the ace and try a spade to the ♠8. North can win, and might decide that, if partner has the ♠A, that ♥Q looks the most troubling for declarer. After that, If declarer tries to draw trumps, South can now rise with the ace and draw a third trump to remove the chances of another heart ruff. South is likely to lead a spade which North will win their ace and now North has a dilemma. Looking at a possible diamond trick source in the dummy and the heart finesse onside for declarer, it might be best for them to cash out any tricks their side might make. Do they try spades or switch to clubs? A club switch looks like it could yield more tricks if South has lead their fourth highest spade. On a club switch, declarer must duck in case the ♦K is offside, South's queen will win and they'll return a club back into East's ♣AJ. Declarer can now play a heart to the king, and a heart back. Good news for East as the queen appears, and they can just finesse the diamond for eleven tricks. Some Easts may choose to pre-empt and open a heavy 3♣, after which South has a tricky decision to make. After pass-pass, many Souths will have opinions over what to open in third seat. North-South could bid quickly to 4♠, or East-West could steal a club part score on a very good day, or may end up sacrificing in 5♣. Leading the top club against 4♠ is fatal for the defence as South now has a very easy run to their desired ten tricks (five spades, one heart, two diamonds, one club and a diamond ruff). On a diamond lead, many Souths will try to play a heart to their queen to make the tenth trick; with the king offside, this simple play will cause us to go down one. A key point for West is never to try to cash the ♣A, as this trick won't be going anywhere. With an opening hand opposite an opening, it's certainly going to be at least a game, but which one is right? If you just had one bid, for sure you would pick 3N with the super flat 3433 shape, but bridge is not a race, and it's good to get partner involved. Bidding 2♦ or 2♥ would show more cards than we have, and we cannot make a raise in spades and risk partner passing, so we pick the semi-natural 2♣. Here we are grateful to hear 2N from partner, showing 15-19 and, more importantly, a balanced hand. This is all we need to hear and we can now place the contract of 3N (not worth 4N with a max 31HCP combined and no trick source or ruffing values).
