TABLE ETIQUETTE

Board in play must remain on the table in the correct orientation.

Do not touch **bidding box** until you know what you intend to bid.

Leave bids on the table until the opening lead is faced.

Make opening lead face down, so that partner can ask questions if they wish. Partner may not ask questions until you have done this.

Save time - write contract in personal score card after the opening lead has been made.

Whoever is in control of **Bridgemate** should enter details and opening lead before play of contract.

During play **Dummy** must not indicate to declarer what they should play. If a suit is called for but no particular card indicated, play the lowest.

Save time - at the end of play, confirm results with opponents, shuffle and return cards to the board. Enter score into Bridgemate and ensure you give it to an opponent to check and confirm result. Make sure all players at the table have a chance to see the result. **Only then** should you fill in your own scorecard.

Director please!
