| Note <br> 3 LHO Doubles our 1NT - partner's double = "please redouble" <br> (or) Partner's bid = transfer one up into 5+ card suit ( $\mathrm{XX}=\mathrm{C}$ ) (or) may wriggle after opener's redouble <br> RHO Doubles our 1NT - -opener bids or partner transfers into 5 card minor (or) we wriggle - seeking 4-4 0r 4-3 fit <br> Wriggle Bid 4 card suits upwards seeking 4-3 fit <br> 4 GHESTEM 2NT $=2$ Lowest unbid suits, $3 C=2$ Highest unbid suits, Cue $=H$ \& L unbid suits |  |  |  |  |  |  |  |
