

Bridge 1– Bidding Part 1 Course Plan

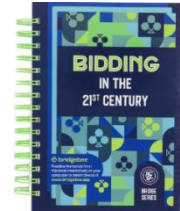
(September 15 – October 27, 2026; Tuesday afternoon, 1:00-4:00 pm)

1	9/15	MiniBridge (1,2, 8:284)	Experiential learning by playing. Fundamentals: etiquette, card deck, shuffle, deal, card rank, play to a trick, ruff using trump, hand valuation, partnership, determine who plays the hand, set contract, play hand. Suit rank, scoring, make PLAN
2	9/22	MiniBridge (3:76, 4:109)	Strategies to take extra tricks (Promotion, Length). Guidelines to improve partnership play. Initial lead by defender.
3	9/29	MiniBridge (5:152,6:204, 7:248)	More strategies to take extra tricks (Finesse, Ruff in Dummy, Discard Losers on Extra Winners in Dummy). Putting PLAN together – entries, holdup (duck), unblock
4	10/6	1, 2, 4a	New language of bidding to win auction for right to decide contract; 1-level Suit Openers; Respond to Major Suit Opener
5	10/13	4b	Continue Respond to 1-level Major Suit Opener; Respond to Minor Suit Opener; <i>Length</i>
6	10/20	5	Opener Rebid to 1-level Suit Opener; <i>Finesse</i>
7	10/27	6	Responder Rebid to 1-level Suit Opener; <i>Ruffing</i>
