- Complete the set of basic bridge bidding and playing skills to be able to play with other people

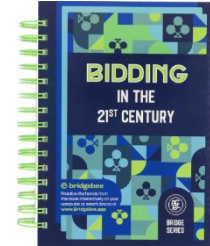
