Subject: Bridge Learning Software Choices

1. **Play Minibrige** (<https://www.acbl.org/minibrige/>)
[Have to specify strain (suit/NT and how many tricks over 6 try to take (target/contract). Start with 1. As get more guidelines, try for other bonus points.]
2. **Learn and Play MiniBridge** hands (<https://www.nofearbridge.co.uk/minibrige/>)
[Looks like MiniBridge. See HCP announced per player. Have to specify Part Score or Game contract in which strain (suit/NT) and how many tricks over 6 try to take (contract). Start with 1. As get more guidelines, try for other bonus points. Has tutoring commentary with playing strategy tips, can replay, can choose different contract..]
3. **Bridge War becoming Bridge Battle**, new; play MiniBridge in a videogame format (www.acbl.org/bridgewar/)
[Have to specify an avatar. Can choose to play with or without a Hero suit; just part-score contracts or all 13 tricks. Still under construction.]
4. **Beginners Booklet** (<https://www.nofearbridge.co.uk/minibrige/>)
[Good start for basic play of hand: make a PLAN, strategies, leads]
5. **Audrey Grant's Bridge App** (<https://www.betterbridge.com>)
[Download complimentary app. Can sample functions. Website also has video lessons that accompany textbooks.]
6. **Bridge Base Online (BBO)** (<https://www.bridgebase.com/>)
[Many play-for-free options. Fee to play in Games to earn masterpoints. Local Clubs online Duplicate games (Virtual Clubs). Play Casual and Solitaire for free. Pay for Robots. Play with friends. Play Matchpoints and see what other people did on hands. Look at History and discuss plus more.]
7. **Best e Bridge** (<https://www.bestebridge.com/>)
[Good place to practice a specific convention with many different hands. Has other practice as well. You can try a few hands for free before purchasing access. You can look at dropdown lists to see the number of available practice hands, e.g. Stayman and Jacoby Transfers (under Transfers) have over 50 hands each.]
8. **BridgeBee** (<https://bridgebee.app/>)
[Search on ACBL. Practice the exercises and hands from the ACBL Bridge Series Bidding in the 21st Century textbook. Also can get Deals from ACBL Bridge Series Play of the Hand in the 21st Century textbook and 3 additional sets of hands to play. You can try a few hands before purchase. Also contains other material from other authors.]
9. **Shark Bridge** (<https://thesharkbridgecompany.com/>)
[Access fee. No charge for Robots. Robots didn't match ACBL Series but enhancements are made frequently including a new feature to allow adjustments to Robots. Teachers use Teaching Console in online classes.]
10. **Tricky Bridge** (<https://www.trickybridge.com>; download app to Apple or Android smartphone)
[Targeted towards young adults but also kid-friendly who are gamers. Way to maybe get young people in your life interested in the game. One woman loaded for 9 year-old grandson who learned enough on own to play bridge together.]
