## After The Takeout Doubler Bids Again

LHO Has Opened, Partner Makes a Takeout Double, RHO Passes, I Bid and Partner Bids Again, Now What Do I Do?

## What We'll Talk About

- Last week we considered the kind of hand the takeout doubler will have when she chooses to bid again.
- This week we are looking at what you should do when that happens.

  - 1♦ dble pass 1♥
  - pass 1nt pass
- Your hand:

Your bid: Pass

- Partner has described a hand with 18-21 points.
- Balanced with a diamond stopper.
- No bid you make is forcing.
- Stayman and transfers do not apply.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♦ dble pass 1♥

pass 1nt pass

Your hand:

- ▲ A 4 2
  ▼ J 9 7 3
- ♦ 10 5
- **♣**9843

Your bid: 2nt

- Partner has described a hand with 18-21 points.
- Balanced with a diamond stopper.
- No bid you make is forcing.
- Stayman and transfers do not apply.
- Invite with 4-6 points

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♦ dble pass 1♥

pass 1nt pass

Your hand:

- **4** 2
- 🕈 Q 10 9 4 5
- ♦ 8 5
- **♣**9843

Your bid: 2\* weak to play

- Partner has described a hand with 18-21 points.
- Balanced with a diamond stopper.
- No bid you make is forcing.
- Stayman and transfers do not apply.
- Rebid your suit with 5- cards.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♠ dble pass 2♦
  - pass 2nt pass
- Your hand:
- **◆**54
- **♥**94
- K 8 6 5 3
- **♣**9843

Your bid: Pass

- Partner has the same hand here: 18-21.
- Balanced with a spade stopper.
- You might be better off in diamonds, but the 3-level is too high with this hand.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♠ dble pass 2♦
  - pass 2nt pass
- Your hand:
- **◆**54
- **♥**94
- 🔶 J 10 8 6 5 3
- **◆**9843

- Partner has the same hand here 18-21.
- Balanced with a spade stopper.
- 3 is not forcing and suggests you want to play it there.
- If partner bids on, he's on his own.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♠ dble pass 2♦
  - pass 2nt pass

Your hand:

- **◆**54
- **v** 9 4
- K Q J 6 5 3
- **♣**9843

Your bid: 3nt

- Partner has the same hand here: 18-21.
- Balanced with a spade stopper.
- Bid 3nt with such a good suit.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♠ dble pass 2♦
  - pass 2nt pass

Your hand:

- **◆**54
- **v** K 9 4
- K Q 6 5 3
- **◆**9843

Your bid: 3nt

- Partner has the same hand here: 18-21.
- Balanced with a spade stopper.
- Also bid 3nt with 7+ points.

## The Takeout Doubler Bids a Suit

LHO Partner RHO You

1♦ dble pass 1♥

pass 1♠ pass

Your hand:

- **◆**54
- **v** K 9 4 2
- •653
- **♣**9843

Your bid: pass

- When partner makes a takeout double,
- Bids a new suit or
- Raises your suit,
- Without being forced or invited,
- Partner has at least 18+ points.
- When partner bids a new suit, she shows 5+ cards.

## The Takeout Doubler Bids a Suit

LHO Partner RHO You

- 1 dble pass 1♥
  pass 1♠ pass
  Your hand:
  ♦ 5 4
- ▼K942
- ♦ Q 10 5 3
- **♣**843

Your bid: 1nt

- Show partner that you don't particularly like spades, but you have a few points.
- Here, your 1nt shows a few points and a stopper in the opponent's suit.

## The Takeout Doubler Bids a Suit

- LHO Partner RHO You
- 1♦dblepass1♥pass1♠pass
- Your hand:
- **▲** 10 5 3
- 💙 Q J 9 4
- 10 5 3 2
- ♣ A 10

Your bid: 4♠

- Partner has a minimum of 18 points.
- You have 7 and a fit with partner's suit.
- You must bid the game.

# When the Takeout Doubler Jumps, it Shows a Huge Hand

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♦ dble pass 1♥
- pass 2♠ pass

Your hand:

- **◆** 5 3
- 🕈 J 7 4 2
- 5 3 2
- **♣** 10 7 5 3

Your bid: pass

- Partner has a minimum of 21 or more points.
- You must make a game try, unless you have...

## After You Have Shown Some Values, Partner Can Invite Game

- LHO Partner RHO You
- 1 dble pass 2♥
  pass 3♥ pass
  Your hand:
- ♠ Q 3
- **v** A 7 4 2
- ♦ 4 3 2
- ♣K632

Your bid: pass

- Your 2 bid shows 9-11 points.
- Partner wants to know if you are closer to 9 or 11.
- You can pass with a minimum 9 but bid game with 11 or a good 10.

## After You Have Shown Some Values, Partner Can Invite Game

- LHO Partner RHO You
- 1♦ dble pass 2♥ pass 3♥ pass
- Your hand:
- **≜** 3
- **•** A K 7 4 2
- **♦**432
- ♣K632

- Your 2 bid shows 9-11 points.
- Here you have a very good 10 points... you should definitely bid on to game.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♦ dble pass 1♥
  - pass 1nt pass
- Your hand:
- **≜** 3
- **v** J 9 7 4 3 2
- **♦**43
- **♣**8632

Your bid: 2♥

- Partner has a strong hand, 18-20.
- But what is the best contract?
- Surely, the hand will play better in hearts.

LHO Partner RHO You dble pass 1♠ 1 pass 2 pass Your hand: **♦** Q 9 7 3 ♥ 2 ♦ 4 3 2 ♣Q632

- Again, partner has a strong hand.
- But what is the best contract?
- Best leave well enough alone.

- LHO Partner RHO You
  - 1♠ dble pass 1nt
  - pass 2nt pass

Your hand:

- ♠ Q 10 7 3
- ♥A2
- K 3 2
- **♣** 10 9 3 2

Your bid: 3nt

- Your bid showed 6-10 points.
- Partner wants to know if you are on the high side of that range.
- You are.

- LHO Partner RHO You
- 1♣ dble pass 1♥ pass 3♥ pass
- Your hand:
- **▲** 3
- 🕈 J 9 7 5 2
- ♦ 6 3 2
- **♣** 10 9 3 2

- Partner is begging you to go on with any scrap of value.
- You don't have much, but your 5<sup>th</sup> heart and your singleton are scraps enough.
- Bid the game.

## **Final Thoughts**

- The hands we've been discussing do not come up often.
- You want to be able to handle them when they do.
- Whenever partner bids again after making a takeout double, she has a strong hand.
- You should try to find a game with only a few values.
