## What Kind of Hand Do You Need To Bid On

- In order to bid on, your hand needs three criteria.

1. At least 4 trump - 9 trump total between you and your partner (most important)
2. Good distribution - not 4-3-3-3
3. No wasted values in the opponent's suit.

## Partner Balances Then You Bid On

- When the opponents choose to stop at a low partscore, it is often necessary to balance.
- To compete for a partscore of your own.
- To push the opponents higher where they might be defeated.
- This involves a bit of risk.

## You Make a Takeout Double Then

 Raise with Minimum Values- It is good bridge to double with good distribution and 11 or 12 points.
- It is poor bridge to raise when partner bids one of your 4-card suits at the minimum level.
- Once you make a takeout double and partner bid, you are done unless you have extra values.
- The rule is: Do not rebid your values.
