# The Smolen Convention 

## Game Force With 5-4 or 4-5 In the Major Suits

## The Basics

- Smolen is a convention that allows responder to show a game-forcing 5-4 or 4-5 major suits holding after partner opens 1 no trump.
- It is on only when responder has 10 or more points, after a 1 no trump opening.


## Here's a Basic Example Hand

- Partner opens 1 no trump.
↔ K J 542
-A973
- Q 75
\& 4
- Responder starts a Stayman sequence.
- If opener bids a major, responder bids game in that suit.
- If opener bids $2 \star$, this hand is a problem.


## Smolen Solves the Problem

- After 1 no trump.... $2 \boldsymbol{*}$...
- KJ542
-A973
- Q 75
- 4 $2 \downarrow$, responder bids $3 \vee$.
- A jump bid in $\vee$, the 4 card major, tells partner that you have 5 spades and 4 hearts.

North East South West 1nt pass 2 pass 2 pass $3 \vee$ pass
Opener bids 3 nt or $4 \boldsymbol{\Delta}$, depending on the holding.

## Smolen Works With an Opposite Holding in the Majors

- After 1 no trump.... 2 \& ...
- KJ 54
-A9753
-Q75
- 4

North East South West 1nt pass 2 pass 2 pass 3 pass $4 \vee$ all pass

Opener's hand

- Q 10
- K J 6
- AK 63
\& Q 1098


## Sample Bidding Sequence

North East South West 1nt pass $2{ }^{1}$ pass
$2 \downarrow^{2}$ pass $3 \boldsymbol{\leftrightarrow}^{3}$ pass $4 \nabla^{4}$ all pass.

Opener's hand

- Q J
- K J 9
- K Q 75
\& Q J 108

1. Do you have a 4-card major?
2. No I don't.
3. Okay, I have 5 hearts and 4 spades.
4. Good, I have 3 hearts.

## Sample Bidding Sequence

North East South West 1nt pass $2 \boldsymbol{e}^{1}$ pass
$2 \downarrow^{2} \quad$ pass $3 \downarrow^{3}$ pass $3 \mathrm{n}^{4}$ all pass.

Opener's hand

- K J
- K J 9
- AQ 75
\& Q J 108

1. Do you have a 4-card major?
2. No I don't.
3. Okay, I have 5 spades and 4 hearts.
4. I have only 2 spades.

## Garbage Stayman



## Garbage Stayman

- Garbage Stayman allows responder to sign off in a two level suit, with a weak 3- suited hand, short in clubs.
- It is on only with $0-7$ points and only a few distributions:
-4-4-4-1 short club suit.
-4-4-5-0 short club suit.
-4-3-5-1 short club suit.
-3-4-5-1 short club suit


## How Garbage Stayman Works

- Partner opens 1 no trump....
- The convention starts as regular Stayman.
- Responder, with 7 or fewer points, bids two clubs and passes what ever partner bids.
Note: with a 5 card major you will transfer and pass.

## Crawling Stayman

- Crawling Stayman is a convention that allows responder to sign off at the two level with a weak 3 suited hand short in diamonds.
- Once again, the convention starts as a regular Stayman sequence.(Must have 4-4 in majors)
- If opener bids either major, responder will pass.
- If opener bids 2 saying he has no 4 -card major, responder bids 2 hearts.
- If opener has 3 hearts, opener passes.
- If opener has 2 hearts he must correct to spades.
- If opener has 2-2-4-5, opener will bid $3 \boldsymbol{2}$,
