## The Support Double

- Invented by Eric Rodwell
- Is used only in the following situation.
- Opener opens with one of a suit. Usually a minor suit but not always.
- Opener's RHO passes.
- Responder bids one of a suit.
- Opener's LHO makes a suit bid through 2 spades.
- Double shows 3 card support for responder's suit.
- Raise of responder's suit is 4 or more cards.

# Rosenkranz Support Double 

## Support for Partner's Overcall

## Rosenkranz Double or Redouble

- This occurs only as a response to an overcall , when RHO bids or doubles.
- Rosenkranz double or redouble shows:
-6-9/10 points
- 3 card support for partner's suit
- One of the top three honors ( $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{K}, \mathrm{Q}$ ) of partner's suit


## One Important Value of Rosenkranz

- The Rosenkranz support double shows one of the top three honors of partner's suit.
- That helps partner know how good his suit is.
- And it helps on defense, when the overcaller knows that partner has a top honor in her suit.
