## The Unusual No Trump



## General Observations

- Over an opening bid of 1 of a suit, a jump to 2 no trump initiates the Unusual No Trump convention.
- Shows a two-suited hand with at least 5 cards in each of the suits.
- Points concentrated in the two suits.
- Typically a weak defensive bid.
- Played along with Michaels' Cue, covers most (but not all) two suited overcall hands.


## General Observations (cont,)

- Some play the Unusual No Trump strictly for minor suits.
- The majority of modern players play it for the lower two unbid suits.
- Over 1 a or 1『, a jump to two no trump shows - and
- Over 1 เ, a jump to two no trump shows $\vee$ and $\%$.
- Over 1 \&, a jump to two no trump shows $\downarrow$ and


## Suit Strength

- Similar to Michaels' Cue, the Unusual No Trump is used with a weak or strong hand.
- A midrange hand is usually handled with two overcalls.
- Weak hand 6 to 10 points
- Midrange hand 11 to 16 points
- Strong hand 17+ points.

## Responding to the Unusual No Trump

- Visualize your partner's hand.
- Remember, the unusual no trump convention is primarily an interference strategy.
- When your hand fits your partner's hand, bid accordingly.
- When you have a misfit. Get out as quickly as possible.
