

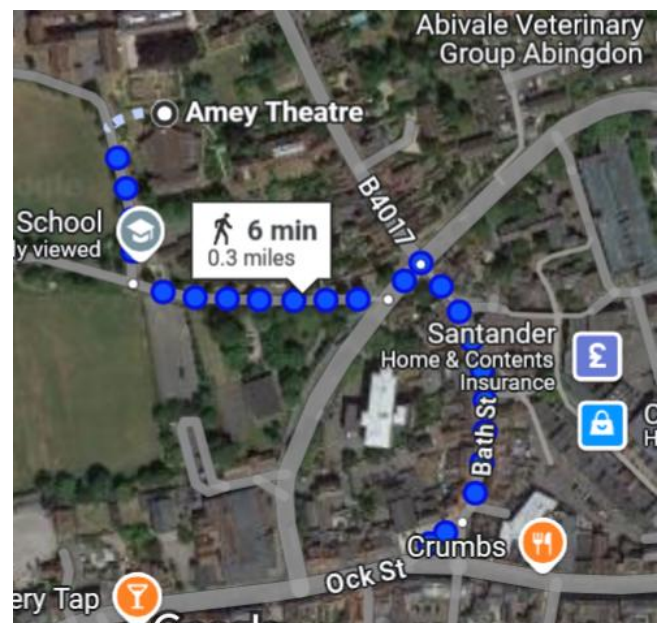
OBA Congress Food

In response to requests last year, your committee can supply a lunch Meal Deal on each day of the congress. This will consist of a packaged sandwich, a piece of fruit, a packet of plain crisps and a chocolate bar, all coming from Tesco and costing £5.00.

Meals must be ordered and paid for in advance, no later than the end of the weekend before the congress. One order per person. Please choose sandwiches from the list. Due to limitations by the supplier we are restricted to 10 of any one sandwich so some choices may be removed from the list nearer the event. First come, first served. Triples have three sandwiches per pack, others two. Gluten free choices are available (Free from Sandwiches & galaxy and the crisps are gluten free). Also make your choice of fruit and chocolate bar.

You are also welcome to bring your own food which you can eat on the premises. The school grounds are very attractive and if it is not raining you can picnic in the open air. **Please Note:** because of pupils' allergies the school is a nut free zone. You may not bring in foods containing nuts.

Alternatively the Abingdon town square is less than a 10 minute walk away and there are multiple lunch sources, from Greggs, through sandwich and coffee bars to pubs and restaurants. You may wish to buy lunch here before the morning sessions to save time at lunch time. A walking map is on the right. Ask Google Maps for directions from the Amey Theatre to Abingdon town square. Bath Street is a pedestrian precinct.



Further away, a five minute drive will take you to a Waitrose store with free parking while you are shopping. The route is shown below. Note that there is no exit for vehicles from Park Road on to Stratton Way.
