2. Matters Arising and Approval of Minutes of 2023 AGM: Agreed. No matters arising

Promotion (Robert Proctor): first 4 items are there to read. Ref the festival. Robert Proctor had had an interesting morning. Played golf at Burford. Partners play bridge at Witney and another online at unaffiliated Club. Another player had set up a bridge club in Burford. Robert will talk to Christine Bishop about the possibility of a game at Burford Bridge Club. Hopefully the club will support an event raising money for Cancer Research. There are probably 30-40 there who play bridge and many not a member of a bridge club, This may be the case at any Golf Club and the same at Gyms. We need to ask the membership and try to encourage them to do organise something for Cancer Research in that week in September. It could be bridge or a golf and bridge. It used to be popular.... Something to be discussed in next PEST team meeting.

Youth (Joan Bennett). Joan had not mentioned Abbey's school work (the schools are up in Bedfordshire, so not sure whether this counts as OBA). Teaching the teachers in schools to teach is important. Charlie has started assisting with Youth bridge.

8. Amendment to Constitution.

The members of the OBA Full Committee recommend that in sections 3.1 and 4.13 the word Duplicate be removed. This has the effect of saying that the OBA is promoting all types of Bridge (not just Duplicate bridge).

Also take out another paragraph to be removed ref all bridge.

Comment.... We must be careful not to support gambling (some rubber bridge clubs have gambling). Although a game of skill there is some luck. We do not think that anyone is playing bridge for money under the auspices of the OBA. There was some issue in the 1970s and it was resolved.

3.1 and 4.13 say - duplicate bridge should be taken to support all types of bridge eg. Rubber and other types of bridge.

The amendment was approved.
