## Congress 2018

The OBA Congress will be held in Woodstock over the weekend of 9/10 June. This is a major event with a <u>Swiss Pairs</u> on the Saturday and <u>Swiss Teams</u> on the Sunday, green pointed as usual; and there will be a new <u>friendly pairs</u> on the Sunday afternoon, with the Sandra Landy Trophy at stake. The friendly pairs is limited to players with NGS rank 9 or lower. (If you are not familiar with the NGS, ask me or ask around in your club.) The Swiss sessions are open to all: you can enter both of them or just one.

There will be several prizes, not only for winners and high-finishers in all competitions but also best ascenders and top non-experts in the Swiss Pairs. There are new catering arrangements this year under management of the providers of the excellent tea on the opening day of the Festival last year.

If you haven't been to the Congress before, this will be a great year to try it.
