

## **OBAN BRIDGE CLUB**

### **Instructions for return to Face to Face Bridge**

We have drawn these instructions up in the hope of keeping ourselves as safe as possible when playing to face to face and also to abide by our own risk assessment which meets SBU guidance.

**In line with Scottish Government legislation, the SBU requires all players to take personal responsibility for complying with the legislation and these conditions of attendance.**

**Please familiarise yourselves with these before attending sessions. These are conditions of entry. Thank you.**

**Vaccination:** players are required to be fully vaccinated against Covid. If you have not been vaccinated, please do not return to F to F bridge at the Oban Club.

**Masks** Following the guidance from the Scottish Government, masks will no longer be required when inside the building, but can be worn if wished and please do so if you have any sort of cough. The club has masks if required.

Players are requested to continue to cover their face when coughing or sneezing.

Players are asked to hold cards away from their face

Sanitiser will be available in the entrance to the Hall and on each table.

Please sanitise between each round

**Testing.** If you have any cold, cough or Covid like symptoms please consider others and only attend if you are sure that you are not infectious and please wear a mask. It would also be considerate to have done a negative lateral flow test in the previous 24 hours.

Anyone testing positive for COVID within three days of attendance should inform the Responsible Person (Morag)

**Distancing:** Although social distancing rules have been removed, you should continue to try to maintain a reasonable social distance when moving between tables.

**Table money:** has increased to £2 to cover costs of masks, sanitiser, wipes, etc. Please bring correct money as we do not want to handle cash. A pre-payment cashless system will soon be available.

**Kitchen .** This will not be in use for the foreseeable future. We have a tea break but please bring your own drink and cup, and snack if wished. Please sanitise your hands again before re start of play.

**Toilets.** The outer toilet doors will remain open to aid ventilation. Please re sanitise your hands before returning to the hall and avoid queueing

**Ventilation:** The door to the inner hall will be left open and the expelair is switched on during play. The hot air system is turned off during play while two oil filled radiator provide heating.
