


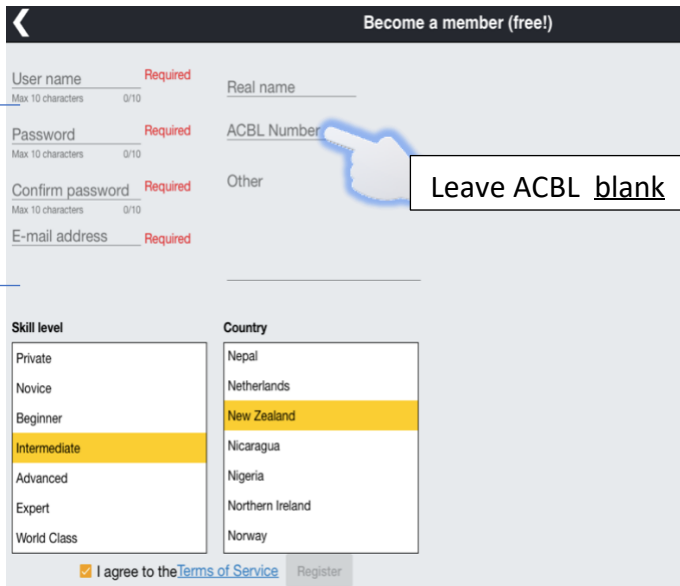
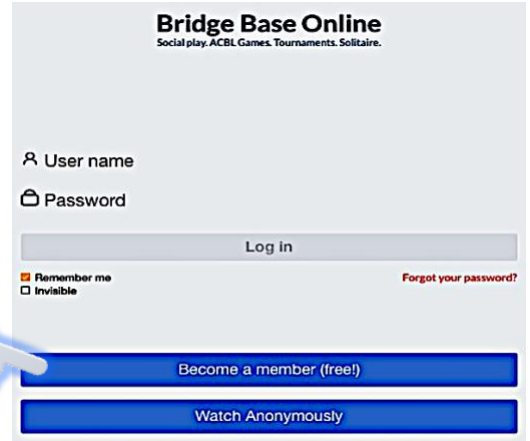
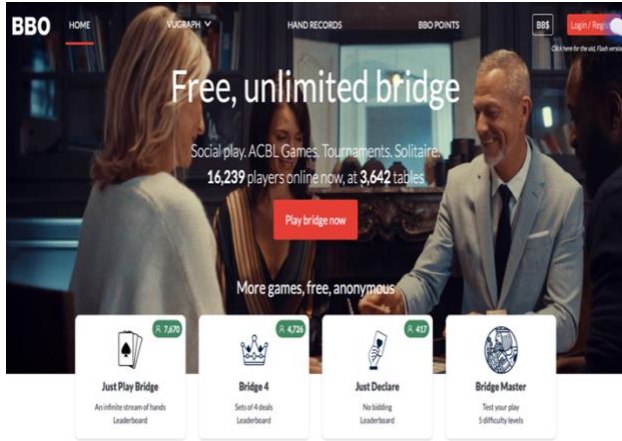
# HOW TO REGISTER with BRIDGE BASE ONLINE (4 STEPS)

## Step 1

Click this link <https://www.bridgebase.com> which takes you to the BBO home page

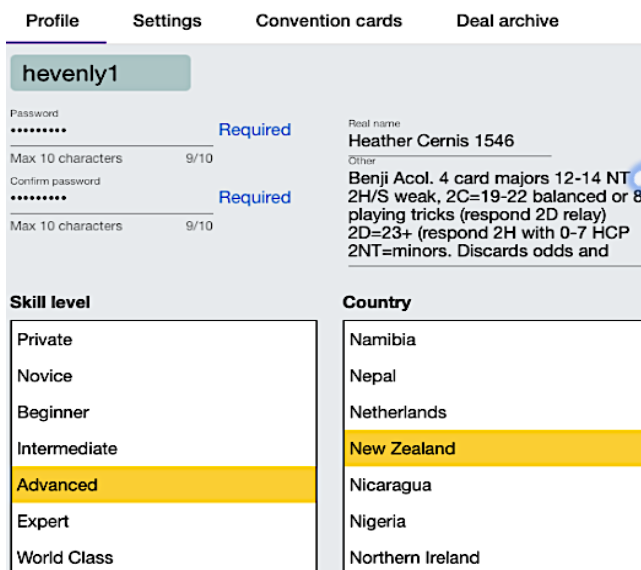
## Step 2

Follow the  prompts below and read the instructions to the right



### Complete the membership form:

- Choose a **nickname** for your user name
- Choose a **password**
- Confirm it
- Add your email address
- Add your real name - not strictly necessary, but it helps other club members to search for you and add you as a friend.  
(Also for the Auckland Bridge Club tournaments, the directors have asked us to add full names and computer number.)
- **Leave the ACBL Number blank**
- Beneath "Other" add your basic system (see example below)
- Choose a **Skill Level**
- Choose **New Zealand**
- Tick to **agree** Terms of Service
- **Register**

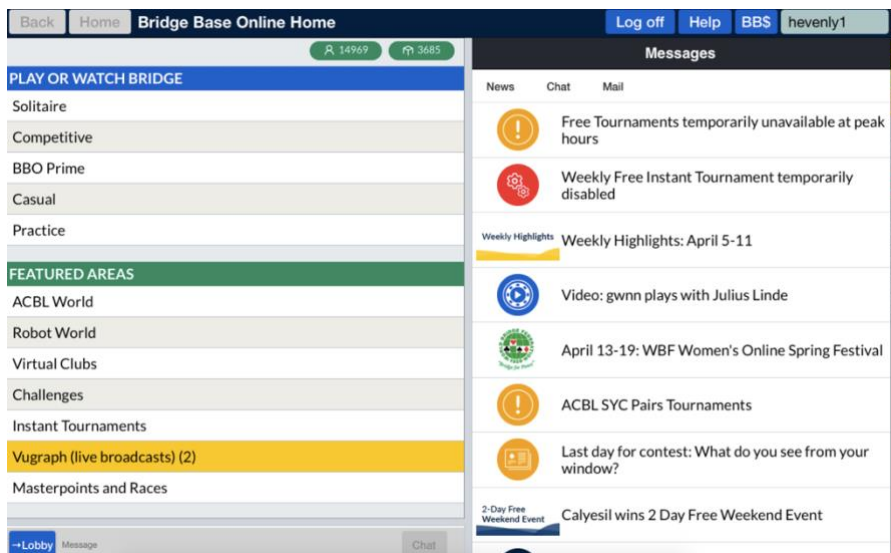
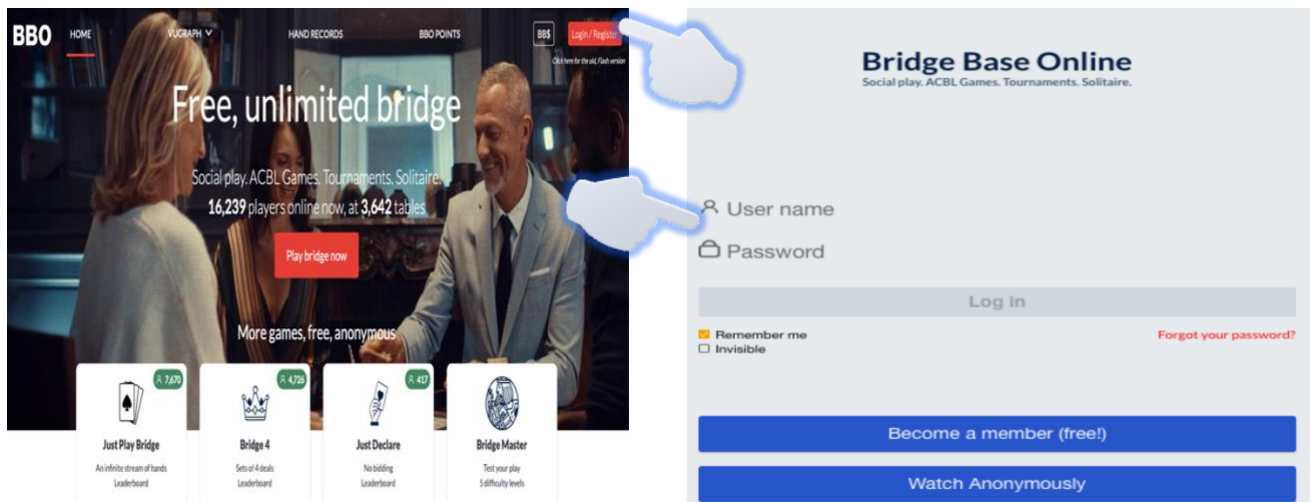

### Step 4
