

PORT ELIZABETH CONTRACT BRIDGE CLUB

ROSE BOWL RULES

1. Play shall commence at 7p.m.
2. It is the duty of the pair themselves and not the Club Committee, to enter for this competition.
3. The competition will consist of a minimum of 11 rounds and the 3 lowest scores will be dropped. Scores will be in percentages.
4. A MITCHELL or HOWELL movement will be played with a MINIMUM OF 24 BOARDS, with a single winning pair per session. A HOWELL movement will be played with 7 tables or less.
5. A regular partnership is a partnership, which enters at the commencement of the year. Should a player become permanently unavailable during the year, the partner may, only with the permission of the committee, pair up with a new player to form a new regular partnership.
6. SUBSTITUTES – a player whose partner is not available may play with a substitute, who must be a member of the Club, unless otherwise agreed by the committee. Their score is recorded in the running log. Each player is permitted two substitutes per year. If additional substitutes are used, these scores will be viewed as dropped scores.
7. Any regular partnership member may team up with another regular partnership member and their score is awarded to each partnership. This may occur ONCE between the same two pairs. This constitutes part of the substitutes.
8. Visitors – visitors may play in the competition from week to week but are not eligible to win the Rose Bowl – visitors scores will not be reflected on the running log.
