2N - bid your minor

3 ♣/♦ - to play

3 ♥ - to play

After 2N - P - 3 ♣:

Pass = weak

3 ♥ = invitational in hearts

4 ♣ = invitational in clubs

Responding to Michaels when only one suit is known - Better method

2N - Invitational or stronger values. If invitational in the major then will bid game depending upon what your second suit is

3 ♣ - Pass or correct to 3 ♦

3 ♦ - Invitational in hearts

3 ♥ - To play

After 2N - P - ?:

3 ♣/♦ = Not accepting, that's my second suit

3 ♥ = Invitational

4 ♣/♦ = accepting, that's my second suit

4 ♥ = To play
