

Payment for Realbridge Sessions

As you probably already know, Realbridge is a commercial operation and the club is charged for each player at our Realbridge sessions. Up to now we have been subsidising that cost from club funds, but from the start of 2021 we will be charging for each player at each session. The charge will be £1 per player, per session.

To limit the administrative burden of collecting the money, we are asking each member who wants to play in Realbridge sessions to pay £10 (or more) on account directly to the club. We will then keep track of how many sessions you play at Realbridge and will remind you when more money is needed. However, it would be even more efficient if you could also keep track and send another payment when your funds are getting low.

To make a direct payment (by Internet Banking or Telephone Banking) you need the following details:

Account Name: Rhiwbina Memorial Hall Community Assoc Bridge Club
Sort Code: 40-38-13
Account Number: 90701882
Reference: Your name and club number (e.g. Jones 421)

The reference is vital to ensure that we know who has sent us the money. If your Internet Banking asks you to distinguish between business accounts and personal accounts, note that the club's account is classified as a business.

If you would prefer to send a cheque rather than use Internet Banking or Telephone Banking, then please contact Gwyn Evans. You can find his email address via the members section of the club website.

Once you have paid some money on account, if you have an outstanding balance and you decide you do not want to play any more at club Realbridge sessions, then please contact Dan Gordon who will arrange for a refund to be paid to you. You can find his email address via the members section of the club website.

If you play at one of the club's Realbridge sessions with a guest, then the table money for both you and your guest will be taken from your money on account.

Payments can be made any time from now onwards. Please ensure that you have some money on account before the first Realbridge session of the new year on January 4th.

If you are part of a couple who both play at Realbridge we would ask that you each make a separate payment under your own club ID as it is much easier for us to maintain an account position for each individual member rather than trying to account jointly for couples.
