

It was announced in the MAY Bridge Bulletin (Page 33) that RHBC made the TOP 50 clubs, that's right, we were #18 out of 50 for our 2022 table counts with 5,583 tables, that's 22,332 players. Thanks to all of you who supported us and who continue to support us!!

GAME START TIME (Both Online and Face to Face)

Our Face-to-Face games start at 12:45, but **PLEASE** arrive at **least 10 minutes** before start time so we can setup the movement and start on time! When you arrive last minute, it causes delays for us all, and can impact the movement.

Our online games start at 12:30, but **PLEASE** arrive at **least 5 minutes** before start time. When you come in with a minute or seconds to spare it can alter the whole movement and often time

the director doesn't see the new arrival and the game is started with the wrong format. This isn't pleasant for the rest of the field, so please arrive a few minutes ahead of start.

PS: we DO start online games a few minutes early when everyone is online and we have an even number of registrants so late entries run the risk of being 'left behind'.

We have been working hard and it is paying off, we are seeing new faces at our games and they are both growing; our Thu game has gone from an average of 12 tables up to 15 and Sat was holding its own at 6-7 and is now we are 10-11. Let's keep the momentum going, tell your family, bring a friend or two or three!

We continue to look for ways to improve the bridge experience, if you have suggestions, please let us know, we love new ideas, even "refurbished old ones".

A few reminders that will help you and help us -

- 1. **Turn off** or mute your cell phone. When phones ring during a game, it breaks concentration. Sadly, they are still ringing during the game!
- 2. **Arrive at least 10 minutes** before game time so we can shut down registration and finalize the movement. We know there are times you are running late, no problem, just call Susan or Izhar, let them know you are on your way.
- 3. Please do **not move** before the round is called, it is distracting to others, if you are moving for coffee or the restrooms please do so **quietly.**
- 4. Please **talk quietly** if you finish a round early, others are still playing and as tantalizing as your conversation is, the rest of us don't want to hear, we want to play our hands.
- 5. **Sitouts happen**, if you are sitting out, please go into the front foyer to chat if you wish, voices carry and again, think distraction!
- 6. Please **don't** update your score card during the round, it delays the round; more below.

Please take the played boards and table card, along with Bridgemate to the setup table, outside the kitchen.

MAINTAINING SCORE SHEET (F2F)

We are delighted you want to keep your score and details, however, please don't delay the game in doing so. You should not be writing when –

- a) You arrive at a table, be play ready, don't start writing in your score sheet
- b) When you are on lead, lead then write so declarer can take a moment to assess
- c) Please don't delay the board and then the round because you are updating your score sheets, update when the round is done.
- d) You are going to delay the board because you are updating your sheet.

SUNDAY ZOOM



My husband and I managed to stay well for our vacation down south. We returned home and he tested positive for COVID. He started taking **Paxlovid** (*), recommended by the pharmacist, the next day and felt remarkably better. It is really nice that the pharmacists can prescribe some things. I called our Shoppers Drug Mart, explained the situation and was able to pick it up right away. And, the pharmacist said "if you test positive at some point get it right away".

I'm telling you this story as I know you are in touch with a lot of people and some may not be aware that you can get Paxlovid from your Pharmacist (it has to be started within the first 5 days of testing positive and you take it for 5 days).

(*) What is Paxlovid? Nirmatrelvir/ritonavir, sold under the brand name Paxlovid, is a copackaged medication used as a treatment for COVID-19. It contains the antiviral medications nirmatrelvir and ritonavir and was developed by Pfizer. It works by preventing the COVID-19 virus from making copies of itself in the body. Paxlovid is the first-choice treatment for mild to moderate COVID in people with a higher risk of severe illness.

Remember before taking any medication you should consult your physician or check with the pharmacist to make sure it is right for you

MISCELLANEOUS TEST YOURSELF! SOLUTIONS

- 1. 2♥ Not strong enough to bid 2S
- 2. **PASS** Two weak for a weak jump overcall at this vulnerability. The HQ is not a good card offensively.
- 3. 2 Unless you play that a positive response in a suit guaranteed two of the top three honors. If you do, respond 2D, waiting.
- 4. 3♠ Rebid your strong six card major-the first priority.
- 5. **PASS** What else?
- 6. 2♥ Partner has a club-heart two-suiter possibly with four hearts and five clubs. If you get doubled, you might decide to run to 3C. Bid 2H confidently to stave off the double.
