

MINUTES OF
SADDLEBROOKE ONE BRIDGE CLUB
2024-25 COMBINED BOARD OF DIRECTORS
January 6, 2025

A meeting of the 2024 and 2025 Board of Directors of SaddleBrooke One Bridge Club was held on Monday, January 6, 2025, at the SaddleBrooke One Activity Center.

In attendance were: Judy Landeck, 2025 President; Sheila Tuhy, 2024 President; Susan Love, 2025 Vice President; Melanie Cohen, 2024 Secretary; Sue Hagerty, 2024-25 Treasurer; and 2024-25 Members at Large Stewart Dresch and Andi Dresch. Absent were Ann Urick, 2024 Vice President, and Sue Colby, 2025 Secretary.

President Landeck called the meeting to order at 3:55 p.m. and welcomed all board members. She announced that SB One Bridge Club will participate in the SaddleBrooke Activity Fair on February 8 at the Mountainview Clubhouse. The Wednesday Ladies Bridge Club and Small Slams Bridge Club will share Booth #36 with us, and they are each to pay \$15 for their share of the booth cost. Bonni Newton will prepare a handout for the event which will include information about her upcoming bridge lessons.

Past-President Tuhy mentioned that she had already submitted the paperwork for the club to continue using the Activity Center on Monday afternoons. This needs to be done each Fall. She also mentioned that a Nominating Chair had to be named in October to put together a slate of Board members for the upcoming year. The 2025 Christmas Party was briefly discussed, and all seemed to like the idea of having a party sometime after the Christmas holidays since there are so many events occurring during that period of time.

VP Love brought up the question of how often the Club allows guests and whether or not SaddleBrooke Ranch still had a reciprocity agreement with SaddleBrooke as to activities. Judy Landeck said that she would question Trish at the administration office about this policy.

President Landeck said that she could not find an up to date copy of the Club's By-Laws. Melanie Cohen offered to type up a current copy that will include amendments made in February 2023, the last time the By-Laws were changed. Susan Love said that she would like to post a copy of the By-Laws on the Club's website, along with a current roster of people who play on Mondays. The modernization of the website was discussed, and all agreed that being able to sign up online would be a great advantage. VP Love will discuss with Bob Murray, our webmaster, how and if this can be accomplished.

The subject of a "coffee kitty" and "sunshine" were discussed. The consensus is that those few who drink coffee during the game should chip in to purchase coffee and that Fay Steele should be asked to continue serving as our Sunshine Chair since she does such a wonderful job and keeps track of birthdays and members who are ill.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by President Landeck at 4:30 p.m. The outgoing Board members wished the new members a great year and offered their help should the need arise.
