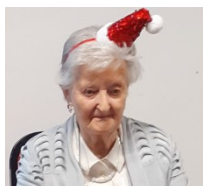
As per usual, many of you helped to set the Christmassy mood, with an interesting array of jumpers ... or other things.



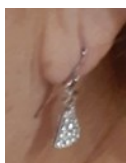
Sneaky! Do you see that slightly guilty look? Who started the nibbles before we were invited to then?



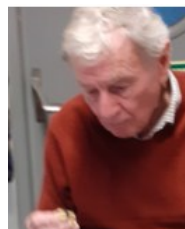
Top gear!
