President Joan Murdoch called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

The minutes from the May meeting were approved.

President's Report (Joan): President's notes were incorporated into the discussion about opening the Bridge Center.

Treasurer's Report (Ronnie): The board requested that Ronnie present an estimated budget for the next couple of months with comparison figures for income based on a game fee of \$8 per game and \$10 per game. It was estimated that with an average of eight tables per game, running four games per week, would create a deficit monthly income of about \$1900 (at \$8 per game) and \$1000 (at \$10 per game). Based on this analysis the board agreed to uphold last month's decision to charge \$10 a game beginning on June 21

Club Manager's Report (Tish): Tish reported on reopening information she has received from ACBL and other clubs that have opened or will be opening soon. She contacted Jay Whipple regarding his reservation system, which is used by many clubs. David Liu did the follow up work on the system and will install it on the SBBC website.
