Learning Bridge

Tony Russ warned some years ago that clubs could not rely upon the newly relocated, retired and experienced players to keep local clubs going—a good quality accessible teaching programme was essential—and it's pleasing to see that Winscombe, Minehead and Frome clubs are running beginners courses this autumn Details are below and on their websites. If you have friends or family interested in learning bridge please refer them to these locations.

Winscombe Bridge Club regularly offer a range of lessons and supported play sessions that cater for players of all abilities. They introduce students to the game of duplicate bridge, which can be played in clubs or at home with friends.

- 1. Year 1 Beginning Bridge course starts in the autumn. No previous experience of bridge or even playing cards is expected. There are 30 lessons spread over three terms throughout the year. Each lesson of 2hrs 30 mins consists of a teaching element with supporting notes and playing cards .The course is run by English Bridge Union (EBU) affiliated teachers and follows the EBU 'Learning to Play Programme'.
- 2. Year 2 Continuing Bridge course also starts in the autumn and follows the same format as the year 1 course.
- 3. Tuesday afternoon social bridge sessions (1.30–4pm) begin with a 30 minute teaching element and are followed by supported play. They use computer-dealt boards with tablet scoring.

Cost: £70 for 10 lessons

Anniversary


Interestingly and definitely worthy of a mention, whilst browsing Frome's website this snippet was discovered:—
