2020/21 SCBA Championship Teams Regulations

- Upper name on chart to initiate arrangement of matches.
- Match set-up process as for Suffolk Online Teams League.
- Teams of up to 6 players but only 4 play on any one day.
- All players must have primary allegiance to Suffolk.
- Matches in the Championship Teams and in the Plate Final to be played on two separate days unless both captains agree otherwise, each captain responsible for set up on one of the days.
- Number of boards per match:
 - Championship Teams: final 48, semi 48, all others 32 in 8-board stanzas, alternate opponents.
 - Plate: 32 boards in the Final. In all other matches other than the Final, 24 board matches played in 2 stanzas of 12 on the same day, alternate opponents.
- No kibitzers, barometer off, no Undos.
- Entry fee £24 per team (includes free entry to the Plate for those that lose first match).
- Match results to be advised to Rick Hanley (rhanley@essex.ac.uk) and Chris Rickard (paulandchrisrickard@gmail.com).
- All teams losing their first match will be entered for the Plate.
- Draw for the Plate will be published when all Round 2 matches are completed.
- A tie at the end of a match shall be resolved by playing extra boards – see EBU White Book para 3.2.2.1.
- Results will be published on the Suffolk Bridge website.
- Overall winning team qualifies to represent Suffolk in the Pachabo Cup.
