


Looking for a partner for Summertown BC Online Tournaments

Before you play for the first time make sure you have registered your BBO Username on the website. You only need to do this once!

Log in to BBO after 5pm, click on "Competitive" and then on "All Tournaments", then search (top right) for "Sum". Click on the event, then click on Partnership Desk (above the blue box which has appeared).

If anybody else is looking for a partner, you will see their username. You can click on their username to see their profile, which will include their real name so you know who you might be inviting to play. If there are no names listed, or no-one who you think would be appropriate for you to partner, click on one of the blue buttons which says "I will pay for only myself". Your name will then appear for others logging on to the Partnership Desk.

Stay logged in and wait for an invitation to play. Once you have accepted an invitation, you are registered for the tournament, and can log out until just before the tournament starts if you wish to (but don't leave it too late!).
