

## Using the BBO “history” tab to review an individual hand



1. You can see all the bidding, as well as all the hands and the final contract.



2. Now if you click on the “hamburger” (the blue box with the three white lines), you can find the option to “Show double dummy”.



3. Initially, this will tell you whether (on best defence and best declarer play) the contract “should” exactly make (green =), make with one or more overtricks (green numbers), or go down one or more tricks (red numbers), on each of the possible opening leads.



4. If you then use the “next trick” button, you can step through the play trick by trick and each time, the system will show whether each card played made any difference to the predicted result, and what should happen on each possible lead to the following trick.

5. Finally, if you’re *really* into this, you can use the “Other Tables” button to look at exactly what happened when everyone else played the same hand....!
