

Checklist for face-to-face play at TBC

[]	Read all the material on our homepage located here
[]	Decide when you want to play (the first offering is 0-750)
[]	Using the contact page (located here) on our website, email us including the name of you and your partner and email addresses for both; you can also send the email to bridgeconnott@gmail.com with the same information
[]	Be prepared to check your email no later than 7:45am in case there have not been enough registrations to do the game; we will email when the game is on as well as when it is cancelled. With
[]	After confirming the game is on, proceed to the club with a mask and no other items being carried into the club
[]	Show your proof of double vaccination and picture ID if you have not done when attending a previous game – you will only have to do this once as we will keep track
[]	Sign a waiver if you have not done when attending a previous game – you will only have to do this once as we will keep track
[]	Be prepared wear your mask except when playing a board and follow all the expectations as documented at each table
