- Redial. Restarts audio and video connections. Use it if the connection fails, or if your video or audio gets out of sync.** (Callout pointing to the redial icon in the bottom center).
- Hide / unhide the other players' videos. Use this if you have a poor connection.** (Callout pointing to the eye icon in the bottom center).
- Your hand.** (Callout pointing to the bottom center area).
- Scores, travellers and rankings for completed boards.** (Callout pointing to the bottom left area).
- Your video.** (Callout pointing to the bottom left video window).
