In 2020, 85% of the deaths were in the elderly. So in 2021, there are less elderly and note there are more Covid deaths, in spite of the jabs! 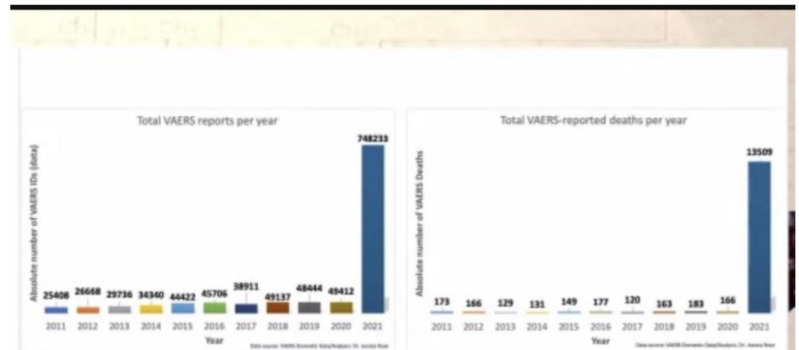

Slide Two

VAERS is a passive reporting system set up after the 1986 law gave all pharmaceutical, hospitals and doctors IMMUNITY from any vaccine reaction. Instead there is a "court" set up with a special master to determine vaccine injury. Over 4 billion has been paid all funded by taxpayers. A decade ago, a study by Harvard requested by HHS showed injury occurred 1 in 39 and VAERS was under reported (because it is passive and it takes 30 minutes to fill out but nothing can be saved. The JAB was a relative risk (which means comparing numerator to numerator) of 95%

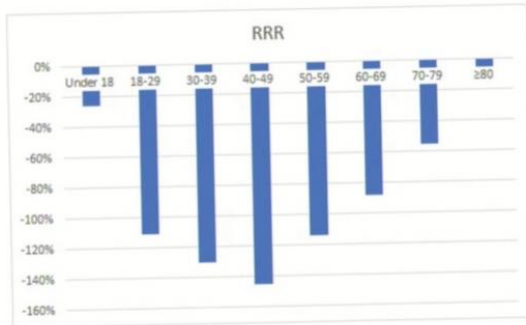
Note there is no reporting of the -140% risk in age group 40-49 or negative 55% in England. Again, US data is being hidden

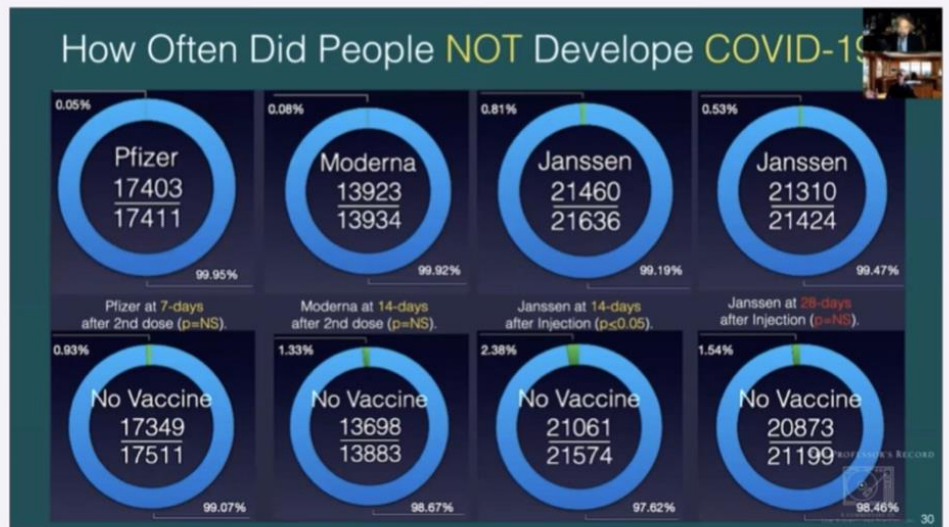

The comparison of numerator to numerator will give the 95% "effective". The denominator is ignored. This is called relative risk. Note the absolute risk (total equation) is .7 to 1.1 % difference in the original data.

Also, this EUA or emergency use authorization could only be granted if there were no other treatments.

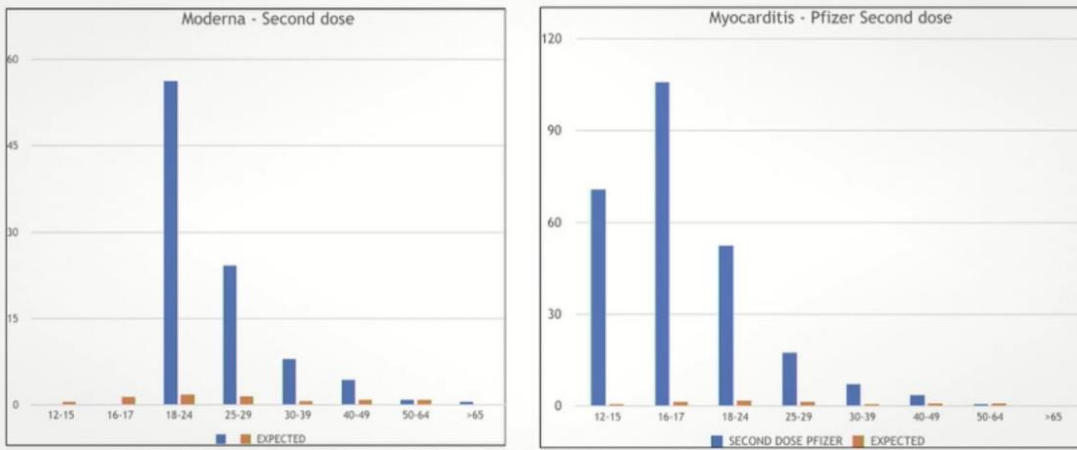

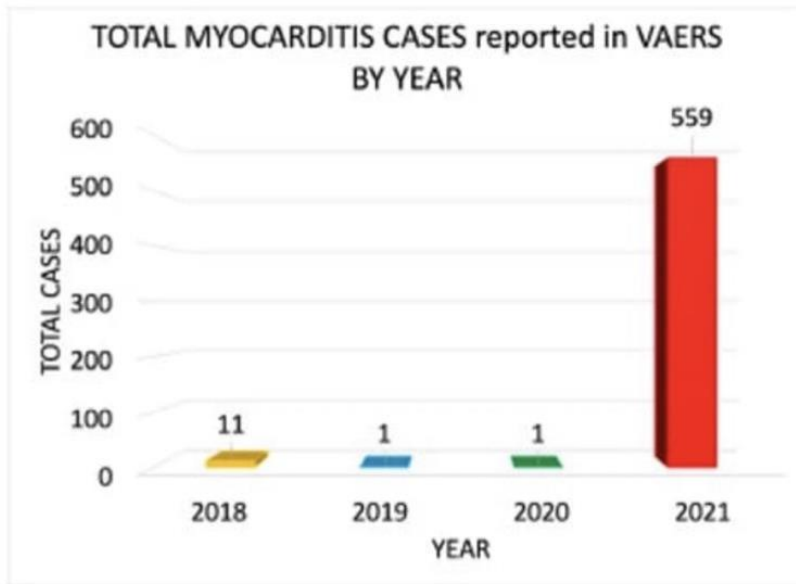
Per Million Doses of Vaccine Administered
