Sue Atwood: Treasurers Report

- Presented May 2016 tournament financial reports and table count information.

- ABA was paid 1/3 of proceeds, \$970.
- Longest Day, Alzheimers Fundraiser, expense \$725.

Pat Williams: Regional July 2017 status report

- Reviewed Regional schedule.
 - Discussed the difference between 3 session & 4 session KO. (It makes a difference to players with 1000-3000 mps. They are less likely to participate in 4 session KOs if they have to compete with top players, due to not enough teams participating). Many people are not "clued-in" to the difference. Discussion of master points awarded for 3 session vs 4 session KOs ensued.
 - Discussion about this schedule: there are 5 side series games, 5 Gold pair games (2 sessions ea), 2 4-round KOs, 4 3-round KOs, 2 compact KOs. Also offering pairs games for Sunday, along with Swiss games.

- Board decided:
 - o 1st KO as 3 session,
 - 1 compact KO in the evening
 - o 3 3-session KOs
 - o 2 4-session KOs
 - o Remove KO 6
 - o Not have compact KO's finishing up same time (night) as other KOs
 - Swiss Sunday, keeping Sunday side game for those who wish only to play
 1 game on Sunday.
 - o 9:30 am, 2:00 pm, 7:00 pm start times
- Hotel allows us to count the food purchased by attendees as part of our food/beverage commitment
- Flyer will be tentatively published to place at Chattanooga Regional next week.

Anne Hitt: Table Search Committee.

Sample table was presented. Set up time is quicker that 4 leg table. Table is a tad higher than our regular tables. Cost is \$31.62+tax each (34.55 each, \$1727 total). Shipping is free. David suggested we store them in their original boxes. H-frame-type table was approved by the Board to purchase for regional(s).

Would we like to move toward getting a Regional in 2018? The option is available. Mobile wants the Regional, but they can't do it after March. David would make the request to the oversight committee via email this evening if the board decides to pursue.


