NEWS FROM THE MUDFLATS

As for most “seasonal” businesses in Maine, that gap in time, which commences shortly after the New Year, and travels through winter/mud season/ersatz spring until mid-May, consists mainly in having enough F2F tables present to hold a sanctioned game.
