Dave Treadwell

(1912-2010)

Our next tournament bears the name of a very special man. Here are some things you may not have known about Dave.

He was an esteemed bridge player and member of the ACBL Hall of Fame. Dave earned nearly 26,000 master points in a career that began in the early 1930's when he was a student at MIT. He won two North American Championships and served on scores of local, regional land national committees. He played in two different events, on the same day, just one week before he passed away, at age 97.

He was known for his great respect for the game and all those who played it. Shortly before he died, a local Wilmington player noted that "Most elite players won't have anything to do with players like me, but Dave was great to everyone." In additional to his bridge prowess, he was known for his sense of humor, which manifested itself in corny jokes, groan-inducing puns and chicanery like laying down cards from a trick deck during a serious bridge hand.

Consistent with Dave's lifelong love of bridge, his memorial service was a special bridge tournament. The tradition continues with this annual event.

IN MEMORIAM

Geraldine "Dini" Romito

Dini came to Delaware in the early 1990's. Determined to help others enjoy the game of bridge, she offered beginner lessons and started her own club, *Shuffles*. As the players grew in their knowledge of the game, she offered intermediate lessons as well as another round of beginners' lessons. After nearly 30 years, *Shuffles* had open games three times a week as well as a novice game.

Dini served food at all her games. Her "pot luck" lunches were yummy! Famous for her private conversations and encouraging discourse, she cultivated every player as though he was going to be the next star player in the ACBL. Always circulating around the room, always in touch with her players.

Dini served on the ACBL Goodwill Committee. She helped other directors in Delaware learn how to use the Bridgemates. She mentored new directors as they learned in game situations. She was always giving, held many special games, cared for her players. Her impact was local, but extended well beyond state lines as she influenced style and grace at the tables.

Dini passed away in September. "How lucky we were to have a friend (teacher, mentor) who is so hard to say goodbye to...."
