<u>Unit 191 Financial Policies and Procedures</u>: Mariee's proposal was very well received and needs only slight tweaking to address,

- a) The possibility of requiring two "signatures" for electronic transfers exceeding \$500, and
- b) Clarification that the Treasurer or "the treasurer's designee" is responsible for inventory control.

John volunteered to handle the inventory and Ray volunteered to be the "Internal Auditor".

Fund Raising:

- a) Approximately 85% of funds have been dispersed.
- b) Some members have contributed <u>directly</u> to the two major clubs, thus the Board does not know precisely how much money has been raised.
- c) Deanna will send table count data to Hugon who volunteered to calculate club income for virtual club games.
- d) Deanna voiced her opinion that club owner's income is not our business; rather, we undertook the project of raising funds to help owners pay fixed costs.
- e) John raised the larger question of club owner's financial stability going forward and the Unit's responsibility to preserve and promote duplicate bridge to its members.
