

Greetings Unit 191 Bridge Players and Friends,

The Unit 191 Mentee-Mentor Committee has developed an online plan for this year's Mentee-Mentor games. As we have all found during this pandemic, changes are needed to protect ourselves and others and to decrease the spread of the virus; thus, we have planned our games with these things in mind.

To be a Mentee: You must be a Non-Life Master player with less than 500 Masterpoints who wants to build your bridge skills and enhance your enjoyment of the game with the aid of a mentor.

To find a Mentor: You may ask someone to mentor you or you may ask the Mentee-Mentor committee to match you with a mentor via an email to <brightleaf.mentee@gmail.com>.

To be a Mentor: You must be a bridge player who would like to give back for the mentors who have helped you build your bridge skills and enhanced your enjoyment of the game.

Preparation: Once you have established a mentee-mentor partnership, share your convention card with each other as well as specifics of what you each would like to accomplish during your mentorship.

Signing up for a mentee-mentor game: To facilitate online play (i.e., to help the club managers run the online games), mentees and mentors need to sign up beforehand via an email to <brightleaf.mentee@gmail.com>. Please provide each player's ACBL number & **BBO name**.

If your partner is unable to play in any scheduled game, let the Mentee-Mentor committee know at <brightleaf.mentee@gmail.com>. While we hope mentee-mentor partnerships will be ongoing, building a mentoring relationship, ***we are happy to match players for single games***. We want this to work for all.

Dates and Time: The games are scheduled online at BBO.

- The **2nd Friday evening of odd-numbered months** (September, November, January, ...),

Triangle Bridge Club (TBC) BBO game at 7:00 p.m. (**VACB252858**).

- The **2nd Saturday evening of even-numbered months** (October, December, February, ...),

The Bridge Academy (BA) BBO game at 7:00 p.m. (**VACB267385**).

Registering for each game: Fifteen to thirty minutes prior to game-time mentees and mentors should go online to register for the game. This allows club managers to resolve any issues beforehand. **MENTEES are asked to invite the Mentors when registering for the game.** This way all mentees will be seated in the same directions (i.e., either South or West) at the table thus balancing the competition.

Game Fee: The game cost is \$8 for each Mentee and Mentor, \$3 of which will

be donated to the ***Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina***.

Masterpoints: While earning masterpoints is NOT the goal of the experience, the games are sanctioned, thus masterpoints ARE awarded.

Raleigh and Triangle-Area Bridge Players: The Mentee-Mentor games are scheduled so as not to conflict with Raleigh games. ***All bridge players in the area are invited and welcomed to play in these games.***

What if I don't want a mentor, but would like to play in the game? You and your partner are welcome to play in these games if you both are Non-Life Masters with less than 500 masterpoints.

We hope you will join us for this extra opportunity for fun, learning, connecting with friends (and soon-to-be bridge friends), and having an outlet for activity this year!
