RESPONDING

RESPONDING to 1-of-a-suit (e.g. 1♥)

With 4-card SUPPORT for opener's suit

INCLUDE DISTRIBUTION

5-9 10-12 **3**♥

4♥ with fewer than 12 hcp 13 +12+hcp bid new suit then rebid 4♥

Note: show a major suit before supporting a minor suit. Do not raise a minor to the 4-level without considering 3NT.

Without SUPPORT

0-5**PASS**

6-9 bid suit at 1-level or 1NT

(always show a suit at 1-level if you can)

10 +show a suit at 1-level or 2-level

6-card suit JUMP 16 +

RESPONDING to 1NT

STAYMAN* 2♦/2♥/2♠

WEAK 5+ cards in suit 2NT 11-12 Invites Game 3♣/3♦ STRONG 6+ cards in suit 3♥/3♠ STRONG 5+ cards in suit

13-18 3NT

4NT 19-20 Invites Slam

0-10 NO GAME: with no 5-card suit PASS

Bid five-card at two-level (except clubs)

11-12 CHANCE FOR GAME: Bid 2NT

or use Stayman then INVITE game.

GAME is ON: Bid long suit at 3-level, 13+

3NT or use Stayman then bid GAME.

*STAYMAN 2♣

When responding to 1NT: if you hold a 4-card major and 11+pts you can use Stayman to find a fit.

RESPONSES TO STAYMAN:

no 4-card major 2

2. 4 hearts

2. 4 spades, but NOT 4 hearts

RESPONDING to STRONG Openings

2♠: MUST respond. 2♦ is the negative = fewer than 7 points, otherwise bid naturally.

2♦/2 $\frac{1}{2}$ MUST respond. 2NT is negative = fewer than 8 points, otherwise bid naturally.

RESPONDING to WEAK pre-empts

Without SUPPORT you need 16+pts to bid. With SUPPORT bid on.

RESPONDER'S SECOND BID

You should know how many points your partner has, so assess the final level: 25 points for game; 30 points and a fit for slam or 33 balanced points for slam in no-trumps.

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OPENING THE BIDDING

Are you BALANCED OR UNBALANCED?

Balanced Hand = No void or singleton and not more than one doubleton. Unbalanced hands are all other distributions.

BALANCED

0-11

12-14 1NT (except with good 5-card major)

15-17 Open suit then rebid lowest NT

18-19 Open suit then jump rebid in NT

20-22

23-24 Open 2♣ then rebid 2NT

UNBALANCED

PASS but see the pre-empt section following 0-11

12-19 Open longest suit

20+ use a STRONG OPENING

Two or more suits to choose from

5-5 Bid higher ranking suit

Bid the MAJOR. Both majors bid 1♥. 4-4

Both minors bid $1 \clubsuit$.

4-4-4 Open suit below the singleton

except with a club singleton open 1♥.

STRONG OPENINGS

23+ any shape or GAME in hand

2♦/ \checkmark / \spadesuit 8 playing tricks 17+ points.

2NT 20-22 balanced

PRE-EMPTIVE OPENINGS

7+ CARDS 5-10pts OPEN at 3-level. OPEN at 4-level. 8+ CARDS 5-10pts

REBIDDING

REBIDDING after NEW SUIT. You MUST bid.

4-card SUPPORT for partner's suit: (1♣-1♥)

12-14 single raise 2

15-17 jump raise 3\(\nstar{1}\)

game raise 4

BALANCED - use table above.

UNBALANCED

12-16 bid second suit if you can or rebid first suit, but MUST NOT bid above 2-of-opened-suit.

17-19 bid second suit if you have one or jump rebid first suit, but try to bid ABOVE 2-of-opened suit. (1♥-2♣-3♦)

REBIDDING after 1NT response

12-16 NO GAME: Bid 2nd suit if you can but MUST NOT bid above 2-of-opened-suit.

Rebid 6-card suit, but PASS with 5-card suit

17-18 2NT 19 3NT

REBIDDING after SUPPORT

How much has partner shown (see responder's tables)? Add your points to his INCLUDE DISTRIBUTION: 25+ go for game; 30+ try for slam.
