Warrington Bridge Club is an affiliated member of the English Bridge Union (EBU). As a member of Warrington Bridge Club your personal details will also be passed to the EBU, who comply with GDPR, and will use your details purely for their legitimate activities related to the game of bridge. You will be enrolled as a member of the EBU, at no additional charge. EBU membership entitles you to a range of benefits, including the EBU magazine, Masterpoints, the National Grading Scheme, and entry to EBU competitions. However, you may elect for your membership of the EBU to be anonymous, in which case the EBU will have a pseudonym on your record against your EBU number, and you will not be entitled to receive EBU benefits or enter EBU competitions. We will assume you consent to your details being passed to the EBU, and used by them for their legitimate activities related to the game of bridge. When your application is approved, you will be asked to pay your joining fee into the Club bank account, sort code 20 29 50, account number 9395 5567, and to add your surname as a reference.

Categories of Membership:

The Club previously operated 3 classes of membership, with different subscription rates: Full Member, New Player Member, and On-line Member. The Committee resolved to simplify and change to one class of membership only, ie Member, from 1/1/25 onwards, and for the lowest subscription rate of £10 per annum, to apply to all.

The joining fee is £10; the first annual subscription of £10 falls due on 1st of January following the date of joining. These include the fee for membership of our venue, Alford Hall, for all except players who only play on-line. Playing fees are listed on the website, and are normally collected every three months in arrears.
