## JACOBY 2NT

Over Partner's 1 Major opener

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In this seminar I am going to concentrate on the 2NT bid and the continuations.
So when should I use a Jacoby 2NT bid?

1) I have the values for game and 4 card support for partners major (if playing five card majors some people will do it with 3 card support - I would not recommend that though -I would still have 4 card support opposite a five card major - nine trumps gives you much more control).
2) A balanced distribution; with a shortage I would prefer a splinter bid.
3) Not a quality $5+$ card side suit, either make a delayed game raise with that or even a jump shift if appropriate.

So what do I do with the following hands?

Remember the following
3 Level bids show a quality 4 card side suit
4 level bids show a shortage and deny a quality 4 card side suit
3 Major is stronger than 4 Major

Hand 1 - 4a - Showing a minimum, no shortage and no decent 4 card side suit (principle of fast arrival).
Hand 2-3a - showing a better than minimum hand, no shortage and no decent 4 card side suit.
Hand $3-3 N T$ - showing precisely a 4-3-3-3 hand 15-16 points.
Hand 4-3-showing a better than minimum hand, a quality 4 card suit (two of the top three honours) at the three level, do this first as opposed to showing a shortage.
Hand 5-4e-showing a better than minimum hand, no decent four card side suit but a shortage.

So what do I bid with these hands

Hand 1

- AKQ2
$\bullet 53$
- AJ7
- Q432

Bid 34 remember you are in a Game Force situation so this is stronger than 4. and it looks like partner has KQxx *'s so your hand fits well, give partner
 slam is a good prospect

Hand 2

- AK87
- AJ4
- 102
- Q432

Bid 30 cue bid to see whether partner can do anything more, notice however with partner having a quality diamond suit these hands do not fit as well as in Hand 1

Hand 3

- AQ32
- 102
- QJ2
- A432

Bid 3a or preferably
4e again it looks like
the hands are fitting well together

Hand 4

- KQ32
$\checkmark$ A4
-KJ10
- A432

Probably best to bid 4NT RKCB

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In summary JACOBY 2NT allows you to:-

- Show Game Force support for partners suit.
- Allow you to exchange additional information at a low level below game, to determine whether you have the right cards for a slam.
- Bid quality 4 card side suits at the three level in response.
- Bid Shortages (when you do not have a quality 4 card side suit) at the four level.
