

## WESTSIDE DUPLICATE BRIDGE CLUB EXECUTIVE MEETING

Moved by Jackie Stokes, seconded by Lynda Marshall, that the meeting minutes of March 3, 2026, be approved as submitted. Motion carried.

### BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:

Summer Location: Lynda Marshall announced that St. George's Anglican Church has installed central air conditioning. She is in negotiations for the cost of renting the church for the July and August bridge games.

### TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Treasurer's Report of March 31, 2026, was circulated and discussed. The Bank Balance is \$700.00 more on March 31, 2026 than on March 31, 2025. Revenue, including Tuesday and Thursday table fees, Membership dues and Miscellaneous Income has increased by \$1515.00. Office, Postage and Game Supplies have decreased by \$173.00. Moved by Lynda Marshall, seconded by Vivian Carnahan, that the Treasurer's Report be adopted as discussed. Carried.

### NEW BUSINESS:

Advertising: Mary Ann McKenzie asked if we are doing any more advertising. There are seven new people taking lessons from Marianne Whitehead, thanks to member Donna Kneller's recruiting. Vivian Carnahan has been relentless and spent significant time doing advertising in the past two years and it is felt that, at this time, no more advertising need be done. The Board members expressed a big thank you to Vivian.

Coffee Supplies: Vivian Carnahan has offered to buy coffee supplies.

Name Badges: It was noted that there are 7 new people taking lessons and they will soon be playing bridge, and as no name badges have been purchased since before covid, it was decided to ask members to purchase a name badge for \$13.00. Lynda Marshall mentioned that there are badges of previous members kept in a storage box. She will update the box and it will be available at all games. Moved by Janet Billon, seconded by Mary Ann McKenzie, that members buy their own name badges. Motion carried.

Increase in Yearly Fees: It was decided to discuss this item at a later date. Lynda Marshall stated that the yearly dues at the Monday game at the Westside Senior Center are \$25.00.

Printer and Ink: Lynda Marshall requested that a new printer, cost \$130.98, as well as Ink, cost \$36.28/cartridge, be purchased from Amazon. Marianne Whitehead has been using her personal computer for printing lesson booklets, as well as other items.

Lesson Booklets: Marianne Whitehead purchased two "Lesson Booklets" from ACBL, one for

Beginner's lessons and one for Intermediate Lessons, cost \$109.89. She has printed them for her lesson courses and put them into binders which she buys at the Dollar Store. As per emails sent and responded to on April 10, 2026, and approval of these items on email, purchasing the new printer and ink, as well as reimbursing Marianne for the Lesson Booklets has been approved.
