

## WESTSIDE DUPLICATE BRIDGE CLUB EXECUTIVE MEETING

### BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:

As the ad in the West Kelowna and Peachland "Coffee News" expired in December, 2025, it was decided not to renew the ad at this time. Our club was reimbursed \$303.21 from ACBL for advertising for new members. Our cost was \$446.00.

### TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Treasurer's Report of January 31, 2026, was circulated and discussed. The Bank Balance is \$445.16 more on January 31, 2026 than on January 31, 2025. Revenue, including Tuesday and Thursday table fees, Membership dues and Miscellaneous Income has increased by \$887.21. Moved by Lynda Marshall, seconded by Jackie Stokes, that the Treasurer's Report be adopted as discussed. Carried.

### NEW BUSINESS:

Immediately after the meeting was opened, this new Business item was discussed with Guest Marianne Whitehead. Jackie Stokes offered the possibility of her taking the Director's Course. Marianne Whitehead gave details of the course when she took it. It was decided that Jackie would begin by learning the computer operation and becoming familiar with the finer details of directing. Marianne left the meeting after the Director's Course was discussed.

Update Member List: Our club now has 36 members with up to 7 tables at recent Tuesday games.

Summer Location: Vivian Carnahan said that we may be able to rent space at City Hall/Library, however, we would need to provide tables, etc. Cost of \$42.00 for first 2 hours and \$10.50 for each additional hour is not a saving. There were parking problems when we played at the Yacht Club during covid and the Legion is not available. It was agreed that St. George's Anglican Church is still our best option.

Monday Lessons: Marianne Whitehead will soon reduce lesson days from every Monday to 2 times/month. In order to gain more experience, she will encourage her students to play at the Senior Centre on Mondays.

Regional Club Manager Responsibilities: Jackie Stokes has not attended or commented on any Regional Meetings and she asked if this was a requirement for the Club Manager. Lynda Marshall said that it is not a requirement and that to attend or not attend meetings is Jackie's decision.

Moved by Janet Billon, seconded by Mary Ann McKenzie that the meeting adjourn at 4:55 pm. Carried.
