A single comment is probably acceptable but it should not be a spark for a conversation as this is distracting (and disrespectful) for your opponents let alone your partner. So please keep it short, keep it simple and keep it one-sided.

What may be a better way to chat with your partner is by a "private message". This has the advantages of not distracting your opponents and only being possible when you have finished playing the last board in any round and before the next round starts.

To use the "private message" all you need to do is click on your partners name on the table layout or the 'People box'. You can then use the chat box to send a message. Your partner can then respond via the same route.
