2. Minutes of the AGM held on Feb 26th 2014:

There were no corrections to these minutes. Andy Cullen proposed that the minutes should be accepted. Sue Evans seconded this proposal and it was agreed unanimously by all the members present.

3. Chairman's Report:

The highlight for me of the year has been continuing success of intermediate bridge, our table numbers are growing and so are we as a club (in fact think this is the highest number of members that we have ever had). We are starting to see some crossover and hope in time that people will take the step into the main club. Big thanks to Rufus for success of Try Duplicate which in a way has led to this.

News – we have organised another seminar with Mike Theelke for 9 May and Andrew Robson will be returning in Oct 2016.

4. Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer distributed copies of the accounts for 2014 and described what capital items had been purchased during the year. He also thanked Dennis Loynes for his role of Auditor. Sue Lane proposed that the accounts should be accepted. Ian Leake seconded this proposal and it was agreed unanimously by all the members present.

The Treasurer then reported that the committee proposed to increase the table money by 50p which would keep WBC in line with neighbouring clubs. This proposal would produce about an extra £1,000 per annum. John Sansom proposed that the increase in table money of 50p be accepted by the members and a vote from the floor was in favour of this by a substantial majority.

The treasurer was asked if the reserves of £8000 were too high and he explained that the county were investigating the purchase of permanent premises and that the reserves of a few thousand would enable WBC to have a stake in this.

5. Constitutional Amendment

The committee proposed two amendments to the Constitution:

- a. Item 7.3 Change in quorum for committee meetings to "A quorum at meetings of the committee shall be half the number of the total committee, rounded up"
- b. Reference to notices within the constitution, add to "by display on notice board and club website"

David Thomas proposed that the resolution should be accepted. Rufus Ulyet seconded this proposal and it was agreed by a substantial majority of the members present.
