VENUE INFORMATION

Address: London MindSports Centre,
21 Dalling Road, London, W6 0JD.

The capacity of the centre is limited and entries will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis. Players are advised to enter as soon as possible for both days.

Getting there: The premises are located just off King Street, less than a two-minute walk from the closest underground station: **Ravenscourt Park** on the **District** line.

To reach the centre from the station, take the exit to **Ravenscourt Place** (signposted "Buses" and "King Street"), go left (east) parallel to the railway, at the end of the road continue in the same direction along a footpath and turn right upon emerging into **Dalling Road**.

Hammersmith underground station is only ten minutes' walk away.

Buses 110, 190 and H91 go along King Street and stop at Ravenscourt Park Station. Buses 218 and 306 go up Dalling Road north of the centre and stop at Ravenscourt Park Station. All stop first at Hammersmith Town Hall, which is also served by bus 267.

By Car: The centre recommends you **use public transport** as it has **no dedicated parking spots** of its own.

If you have to travel by car then note that roads near the centre in Parking **Zone A** have **chargeable** on-street parking on **Saturdays**. Nearby **Zone L** and **Zone M** both have **free** parking **all weekend**, but spaces may be hard to find.

Please allow plenty of time to reach the venue by any method, because of traffic and road/rail works, always bad in central London at weekends.

Refreshments: A range of hot and cold food and drinks will be available all day each day, along with a licensed bar. **Players are requested not to bring their own refreshments to be consumed on the premises.**
